

ABSTRACT

Muslims have become an important segment in Germany's society. Not only that Muslims are the largest immigrants group in the country, but also because Muslims are the largest religious minority and Islam now is the fastest growing religion in Germany. Along with the acceptance of the reality of the immigrants, including Muslims in the country, Germany needs to improve its efforts to integrate more fully its expanding Muslims population. This thesis on the "Angela Merkel Government Initiatives to Foster Muslims Integration in Germany" intends to explore the determinants of the present German government to integrate Muslims population living in Germany. The determinants are discovered by using the concepts of Integration and the theory of Rational Actor Model or Classical Theory. The writer argues that the German government is regarded as a 'unitary decision maker based on rationality'. Therefore, there must be 'raison d'être' for Germany to actively integrate Muslims. Rationality is certainly based on the consideration of benefits and the costs that the German government takes into account by taking such action, given the strategic problems that the government faced.
