Abstract

This research aimed at pursuing any information about factors to lead political dispute between the United States of America with Israel on the issue of Iran's nuclear development program. It also sought any information about factors of the United States under President Barack Obama preferring to impose economic sanctions rather than military sanctions as optioned by its major ally in the Middle East, Israel, against Iran's nuclear development program. Iran's nuclear development program was alleged as an attempt to produce nuclear weapons. Both the United States and Israel then considered Iran nuclear development program as a threat to the global security and generated sanctions against. The United States imposed economic sanctions while Israel preferred to impose military sanctions against Iran. Israel even considered the economic sanctions that were relied on by Obama as ineffective sanctions.
