## **Chapter One**

### Introduction

### **Background of the Research**

In this era, English language has become daily language that is used in most countries as a second language. As cite from Habeeb (2017) in countries that many different languages are spoken, English is often used as the official language to help people communicate. He also stated that English is the language of political negotiations and international business. It has become the international language of science and medicine. It can be said that people who having good English proficiency have more job opportunities in most companies and offices. English language also becomes language of science and technology-which eases people to get access of information around the world. English language gives students access to information and research and there are lot of academic journals which are published in English languages. The first is extroversion. As cite from Jung (2008), an extrovert is a type of one's personality that is shown from the tendency of being active, sociable, brave to take risk, impulsive, expressive, less reflective and less responsible. According to Jung (2008), introverted people focus on the exploration of thoughts and feelings and experiences. It can be said that introvert is the opposite of extrovert.

Furthermore, the extroverted student may have good speaking skill, as Suliman (2015) said that extroverted students easily communicate in the second language even though they might not produce accurate output. Introverted students might get good score in speaking activity if they prepare really well by memorizing what they want to deliver. However, the researcher is aware if in the classroom students are quiet and sometime when the lecturers ask question, they just pretend like they do not listen to the question. according to Hussein (2010) said that students do something which is not important and they just listen to the discussion, take note, and sit quietly.

Based on the researcher's experience during his study time, the researcher realizes that students have different personality in classroom. There are some students who are passive in learning activity and seem like they are lack of attention to the lecture's explanation and there are also some students who are learning and getting involved actively in learning activities. Another thing seen by the researcher in classroom is when students do speaking activity in classroom; they are not fluent. Sometimes they stop speaking too often and what they say is not relevant to the topic. In addition, the researcher also finds out that some students are lack of social activity since they tend to spend their time alone. Thus, the researcher is interested in finding out the challenges faced by introverted students and also the strategies applied by introverted students. #### **Statement of the Problem**
