

ABSTRACT

This thesis seeks what is the impact of Covid-19 Pandemic on Social-Economy Aspects during New Normal Era, Case Study: Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSMEs) in Yogyakarta City and Bantul Regency. In the new normal era, economy sector activities such as Micro, Small, and Medium Enterprises in the Special Region of Yogyakarta at all levels must adapt to current conditions. This thesis uses the theory of Lewin (1951) which focuses on three aspects, namely New Normal, Social-Economy Impact, Micro, Small, and Medium Enterprises (MSMEs). These aspects are explained in several indicators. In this thesis, researcher is very interested in taking the topic that she wants to discuss to fulfil the final thesis entitled the impact of Covid-19 Pandemic on Social-Economy Aspects during New Normal Era, Case Study: Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSMEs) In Yogyakarta City and Bantul Regency because the most significant economic contributor to the Special Region of Yogyakarta is Yogyakarta City and Bantul Regency. This research uses qualitative methods and is supported by primary and secondary data.
