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ABSTRAC

Mental disorder is a clinis syndrom that happened with somebody and correlation with distress and diasability. One of the mental disease is schizofrenia where there is a disharmony in mental, thinking process, feeling and behavior. One of the symptoms of schizophrenia is having hallucinations. client with hallucination are in need of social support from the people around them. Family support especially from the client's family members are expected to be able to control the hallucination with adherence taking medicine.

This research was aimed at identifying the correlation between the family support (care giver) with skizofrenia client adherence of taking medicine.

The research was a deskriptive analytical non experimental by using the cross sectional approach. The sample were 51 people skizofrenia and their family who were this under control in In Care Unit Grhasia Hospital of Yogyakarta and it applied purposive sampling in gaining the samples. The data collection method was done trought questionnaires. the hypothesesis was examined using the corellation test of spearman rank.

The results showed taht most of the 35 clientts with skizofren gained family supports with high category and frequnce of skizofrenia with high category 36 clients. Generally clientts obtained family supports with good category and owned the schizophrenia adherence of taking medicine in care with high category. The result of this research is not correlation between family support (care giver) with schizophrenia client adherence of taking medicine in Care Unit of Grhasia Hospital Yogyakarta (r)=0,104 and significant (p)=468
