Teske (2017) stated that an additional learning tool for the most effective language is Duolingo, as students can learn at the desired language target. There are many languages to learn in the Duolingo application, students can focus on one language to learn more about and have targets for the future. The application has been very effective if the students are serious about using it. Students can open the application at leisure during leisure time.

Duolingo presents four English aptitudes in particular reading, writing, listening, and speaking. The four aptitudes are available during the learning exercises in Duolingo through inquiries, and little messages to be heard and interpreted. There are numerous factors to consider in order to answer this question. Reading is the gateway to learning about what is going on around us and seeing the world from a variety of perspectives. A good reading habit is required for healthy intellectual development and plays a critical role in a person's

achievement of practical efficiency Chettri (2013) Reading can also be defined as a survival kit for a college student in order to get through their college life. Studying necessitates reading. One of the skills in English is writing which must be mastered by English as Foreign Language (EFL) students who aim for written communication such as letters, papers, essays, articles, journals, theses, project reports, etc. Writing has an important role in learning the language for knowledge (Fareed, Ashraf, & Bilal, 2016). Rosdiana (2018) discusses the use of audiovisuals as media to improve learners' listening abilities. Learning media relates to students' modes of communication and knowledge. Other issues revealed by personal student information included lack of self-confidence, fear of making mistakes, shyness toward others, nervousness, the habit of speaking English, never practicing, and having nothing to say Sayuri (2016) Duolingo has provided Practice questions to speak with correct answer corrections. The students additionally need to record their pronunciation to survey their speaking capacity. Krashen (2014) states that the Duolingo application is an online self-guided language education program that guides students step by step through a succession assignment, generally dependent on interpretation. It is pointed to as cognizant learning and subliminal language as understudies hear and read tests of language.

Students can get the benefit of learning English with using Duolingo. A study conducted by Utami (2020) found out that students who agreed to use Duolingo in English language learning there are about 56.52% very influential in learning and who disagree there are only 4.35% of students. The conclusion is that they agree that applying Duolingo can have a positive effect on their English language learning. In addition, Munday (2016) conducted a study which revealed that if teachers combine the Strongly Agreement with the Agreement results the teachers obtained, the teachers observe that 91% found Duolingo easy to use, 82% found it very helpful, 80.4% enjoyed utilizing it and 78.3% were pleased with the app. In comparison, there are not too many students who seem to disagree with these claims.

The purpose of this research was to know, and compare the data produced from research with the facts of society. This research aims to explore the benefits and challenges of English as a foreign language students' perception toward the use of Duolingo on their English language skills. The researcher chose English student batch 2019 to be the research participant in one of the private Islamic universities in Yogyakarta Because the researcher is currently studying there and knows the 2019 class students.

Statement of the Problem

When learning English, students face a variety of challenges. in this instance, Students' English language skills are important in learning English. Therefore, students continue to struggle with mastering English skills. With the availability of technology today, students tend to prioritize their hobbies over learning English. Data collection procedure, the researcher set up an appointment with the participants using the WhatsApp program at a time and location that was mutually agreed upon. The researcher then described the purpose of the research before conducting the interview. As a result, the participants had a general understanding of the study.
