#### **ABSTRACT**

This research is based on a new perspective to improve the public services, supported with information technology which makes the people innovate to create the websites for the service process. Citizen Information System (SI Warga) is a form of e-service in the Patehan Urban Village, Kraton Subdistrict, Yogyakarta City. The research objective is to learn how the implementation of SI Warga Patehan as a tool of public service in the village and what factors are supporting and hindering the implementation. The research method used was qualitative research and the variable used the theory of Van Metter and Van Horn. From the results of this study, findings indicate of the implementation of the SI Warga Patehan less running optimally due to constraints no regulative in the policy of Standard Operating Procedure and it affects in the other variable.
