ABSTRACT

READINESS OF MEDICATION MANAGEMENT USE IN RS PKU MUHAMMADIYAH GOMBONG ACCORDING TO HOSPITAL ACCREDITATION 2012

Background: Cited on Law No. 44 of 2009 section 40, in the effort of service quality improvement, the hospital has to do accreditation periodically every three years. Medication management and use that become hospital accreditation standards consist of seven key elements; 1) management and organization, 2) selection and procurement, 3) storage, 4) ordering and transcribing, 5) dispensing, 6) administration, and 7) monitoring.

Objective: To determine the preparation and advisability PKU Muhammadiyah Gombong on fulfilling the medication management use standards as the one of hospital accreditation 2012 objective.

Methods: This research is a qualitative case study design that the results are presented descriptively. The subjects were hospital management, executive staffs and patients. The object was the implementation of the medicine management and use in the hospital accreditation 2012. The instrument of this study was the surveyor's check-list of hospital accreditation 2012.

Results and Discussion: Average readiness management and use of the drug to achieve a score of at least 80.31% of the standard 80%. Management, procurement, ordering, administration and monitoring goals have exceeded the minimum standards, while the storage and distribution of pharmaceutical goals are still below the minimum standard score. Factors that affect the achievement are human resources, facilities, finance, culture and socialization.

Conclusion: Policy and implementation to seven goals of medication management and use are not yet fully equipped. Recommendations that need to be done as early as possible is a self-assessment by the accreditation team work and complementary policies, standard operating procedures, guidelines, documentary evidence in the medication management and use objective.
