Abstract

Textbook is one of the essentials materials that teachers need in the teaching and learning process. This research focuses to investigate the perceptions of textbook quality and strategies of using a textbook that is perceived by English teachers. This research was conducted in one of the state vocational high schools in Yogyakarta involving one female and one male English teacher that have taught more than ten years. This research used descriptive qualitative. For the data gathering technique, this research used interviews and document analysis to enrich and gain detailed data from the participants. The first results of this research revealed that the government English textbook quality is good because the teachers' perception showed more strengths than the weakness and fits the criteria of good English textbooks in terms of practical consideration, activities, subject, and content. However, the government needs to design the textbook based on the state vocational high school because the textbook specifically for state vocational high school is not available. Also in terms of layout and design, it needs revision. This can be in the form of instruction about how the textbook can be used. In terms of language use in the textbook, the textbook needs improvement in grammar explanation in brief and easy examples. The textbook also needs to represent diversity range registers and accents. The second results of this research showed three strategies of using textbooks, namely; using additional materials, rewriting own materials, and replacing activity.
