ABSTRACT

The percentage of women today is increasing. It did not rule out the possibility of a sense of competition from men. Previously, the perception of women who only fit in the kitchen has now changed. From year to year, the activeness of women who work is increasing, especially in the government sector. A woman can take part in matters of government affairs if, the woman fulfils the conditions that are suitable for employment. Without having to feel burdened by the idea, it is difficult to blend into political life, especially for a woman who is always under the auspices of a man. For this reason, this research examines the fulfilment of women's representation in the 2019 legislative elections in Pangkalpinang City.

The purpose of this research is to find out how to fulfil the quota of women in the Regional Representative Council in Pangkalpinang city. Therefore, it also aims to explore experiences about women who have been elected to council members and their factors that influence them to join the election. The method used in this research is descriptive qualitative with the six number of interviewees that consisting of 3 elected women legislative candidates and three political party officials who supported the elected women candidates. Thus, data collection techniques in this research used interviews and documentation,

From the results of the research, fulfilling women's quota in the Pangkalpinang City council chair is still categorized small due to the lack of familiarity of prospective women by the community that led to difficulty getting high voting results.
