Multilateral diplomacy efforts made in the era of Iranian President Hassan Rohani more moderate. In an effort to maintain its nuclear program amid opposition to the West, Iran through diplomacy or official channels trying to achieve its national interests to comply with international rules official and legitimate. Government and the Iranian people never backward in defending their rights in the civil nuclear field in accordance with international treaties, the Charter of the International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA), as well as the principle of national sovereignty of Iran itself.
