### **CHAPTER ONE**

#### INTRODUCTION

In this chapter, the researcher explains background of research, problem statement, research questions, purpose of research, advantages of research, and outline of research.

### **Background of the Research**

Motivation is the most important factor for everyone because it influences their behavior and performance. Motivation also supports someone to do something, such as to eat, to work, to study, etc. Besides, it also supports students to reach their goals and target of lives. As citied in Marguerett (2007), Heinich, Russel, and Smaldino (2002) concluded that motivation is an internal part that leads people to pursue certain goals and experiences. Besides, motivation is defined as processes that energize, direct and maintain someone's behavior (Santrock, 2009).

The importance of motivation influences many sectors, one of them is in the educational sector. In this sector, motivation influences successful teaching and learning in school. It supports students to achieve their goals and learning objective, such as on learning achievement. As citied in Choosri & Intharaksa (2011), Yu-mei (2009) defined that motivation is one of the important factors that influence on student's achievement.

There are several students' motivations in educational sector, one of them in writing research paper. In English Education Department at Universitas

Muhammadiyah Yogyakarta for instance, writing a research paper has become an additional skill for them, that is very important to increase their writing ability. Besides, writing research papers is becomes one of requirements to get scholarships. There are many scholarships that students of English Education Department at Universitas Muhammadiyah Yogyakarta can achieve, which come from their university or other institution. At Universitas Muhammadiyah Yogyakarta for instance, the university offers Beasiswa Utama for their students in every year. Students can also apply overseas non- degree scholarships in overseas. The last importance of writing research paper is opening students' opportunity to present their paper in many conferences. Based on the data from English Education Department of Universitas Muhammadyah Yogyakarta, there are four different conferences that students joined from 2011 until 2014. In this conference, three students presented their papers and all of them were student batch 2011. Finally, the last conference students joined were

the 11<sup>th</sup> Asia TEFL International Conferences in 2013. Seven students presented their papers in this conference, which consisted of a student of batch 2012 and six student of batch 2011. These conferences are conferences that students of English Education Department at Universitas Muhammadiyah Yogyakarta joined after writing and submitting their research paper. Based on the facts above, the researcher is interested in investigating students' motivation in writing research paper at English Education Department of Universitas Muhammadiyah Yogyakarta.

### **Problem Statement**

Motivation is very important for everyone, especially for students of English Education Department at Universitas Muhammadiyah Yogyakarta. In this department, there are differences on students' motivation in writing research papers. Only several students are motivated in writing research papers. It was based on the number of students who written and presented their papers in conferences.
