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Abstract

Basically, the final objective of learning is to produce the students who have skills and knowledge to solve the problem. With ability in solving the problem, students will be able to face the problem in society. This research aims to determine the English teachers' perception toward the implementation of problem solving based learning in English teaching and learning process at SMP IT Alam Nurul Islam Yogyakarta. The researcher used qualitative approach in conducting the research. An interview was conducted to gather the data from two English teachers of SMP IT Alam Nurul Islam Yogyakarta. The findings showed that all participants understood the concept of problem solving based learning.
