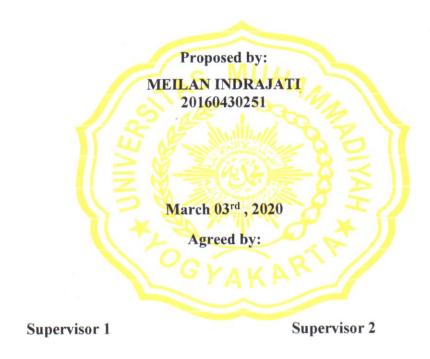

#### **ABSTRACT**

This study aims to analyze the influence of trust, benefits, ease to use, security, and risk on selection of e-money by millennial generation. Subjects in the study were students at Yogyakarta University who had been accredited A. Data in this study were obtained from the distribution of questionnaires totaling 200 respondents. Data analysis uses multiple linear analysis. The test results show that the trust, benefit, ease to use, security, and risk of e-money selection by millennial generation simultaneously have a significant effect. Trust has a positive and significant effect on the selection of e-money by millennial generation. Benefit have a positive and significant effect on the selection of e-money by millennial generation. Ease to use has a positive and significant effect on the selection of e-money by millennial generation. The risk has a positive and not significant effect on the selection of e-money by millennial generation.

Kemudahan berpengaruh positif dan signifikan terhadap pemilihan e-money oleh generasi milenial. Risiko berpengaruh positif dan tidak signifikan terhadap pemilihan e-money oleh generasi milenial. Risiko berpengaruh positif dan tidak signifikan terhadap pemilihan e-money oleh generasi milenial.
