ABSTRACT

The research aim sat analyzing how far is the influence of GDP, minimum wage, population number to unemployment in Indonesia. The object of the research is the cause factor of unemployment in Indonesia. The data was collected from 33 provinces in Indonesia from 2010 to 2014. There were 33 samples in this research from several institutes such as Badan Pusat Statistik (BPS) and Bank Indonesia. The method data panel was used to analyze the data.

Based on the analysis, it is shown that GDP and population number has a significant influence to the open unemployment in Indonesia. Meanwhile, the minimum wages does not have a significant influence to the open unemployment in Indonesia.
