ABSTRACT

This research is purposed to analyze and provide the empirical evidence about influence of Local Revenues, General Allocation Funds, Special Allocation Funds, and Capital Expenditures to economic growth at western, center, and eastern of Indonesia in 2009-2013. This research used secondary data which is obtained from financial report of local government (LKPD) in 2009-2013. Research objects are regencies or cities in Special Region of Yogyakarta (DIY), Riau, and Papua. Samples in this research are about 25 of Regencies/Cities in DIY, 55 of Regencies/Cities in Riau, and 50 of Regencies/Cities in Papua. Samples taking in this research used purposive sampling method. Analysis method from this research used doubled linear regression with 5% significant rate. The result of research indicates that is Local Revenues, General Allocation Funds, Special Allocation Funds, and Capital Expenditures have a significant influence to Economic Growth
