ABSTRACT

This research aims at analyzing the opinion of Abdullah Nashih Ulwan in the book of *Tarbiyah Al-Aulad Fi Al-Islam* regarding child abuse. Whilst, the benefit and advantage of this research is to broaden the scientific insight related to Islamic studies on child abuse to be taken as example for muslim especially educators in educating their children and students with appropriate method set by Allah and His prophet.

This research was classified into library research which reviewed the book of *Tarbiyah Al-Aulad Fi Al-Islam* using content analysis. The approach used in this research was descriptive analysis since it benefitted qualitative method, which resulted in information such as descriptive notes and data taken from the text being analyzed.

This research's result indicates that Abdullah Nashih Ulwan, as cited in the book of *Tarbiyah Al-Aulad Fi Al-Islam* on the discussion of child abuse outlining the punishment, stated that when students misbehave and make a mistake it is an obligation for educators to guide and bring them back to the right path. The punishment formulated by Abdullah Nashih Ulwan refers to the guide of prophet Muhammad (peace be upon him) which includes some violent acts such as beating. Abdullah Nashih Ulwan allows beating; however, it must be gradual. In other words, beating or any other violent acts should be done as the last alternative. This implies his sense of toleration toward child abuse. This book, moreover, suggests that there is one certain form of violent act allowed according to Abdullah Nashih Ulwan; that is violent punishment with the purpose of correcting mistakes done by children to be able to regain their nature as students.
