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Abstract

Speaking is one of skills that should be mastered by the students who are learning English to be able to communicate and to express their feeling or sharing their opinion either in formal or informal context. Speaking English in formal context requires Formal English which raises problems for the students. This research aimed to find out the students' problems and strategies in learning speaking using Formal English in formal context at English Language Education Department (ELED). This research used qualitative approach with descriptive qualitative design. The researcher conducted this research at one of private universities in Yogyakarta involving four participants of ELED students, batch 2019. Interview was used as the technique to collect the data. The findings of this research related to the students' problems in learning speaking using Formal English in formal context were the students inability to differentiate between formal and informal English, students' lack of linguistic mastery in vocabulary and grammar, students' nervousness, and students' lack of practice. Meanwhile, the strategies that the students applied were using video, textbooks, and joining group work.
