CHAPTER 1

INTRODUCTION

This chapter focused on explaining the topic of this research. There are various thing to be explained. The first thing is background of the study. After that, there are the limitation of the problem, research question, object of the study, and the last one the benefit of the study.

Background of the study

One of the most crucial things for humans is education. From education we can learn something such as sains, history, or even language to communicate with other person who is from another country so that we can understand others. Ruhiyat (2012) said that the main reason of using media is for the student can easily understand the material so the study will be efficient and effective. An example of media that we can use for the learning activity is video. There are many websites to find videos on the internet, but the biggest website to find videos in this era is YouTube. Snelson and Elison-Bowers (2009) stated that "YouTube, currently the largest and most widely used online video service, is at the epicenter of the expanding video-sharing universe." Teachers can use YouTube videos to give the students new experiences in the class so they will not get bored easily.

YouTube is a mainstream media that everyone can upload a video in there and they can watch freely without paying. This platform was made by Chad Hurley, Steve Chen, and Jawed

Karim in 2005 and thankfully for them, we can search any video for educational purposes. We can find video material such as daily conversation but in a more interesting way because we do not only listen, instead we also watch the people who are doing the conversation. In this way, the learner can be more interested in the material. For this case, Mekheimer (2011) found that there are significant improvements in the learner's listening skills when they watch videos for studying. Actually not only listening skills that can be improved by watching YouTube videos. since we can use subtitles on the video, we can also enhance reading skills and also give more new vocabulary. We also can search for any specific accent to learn, because not every speaker has one common accent. The example when we only listen to the American accent all the time, we sometimes will not understand the word if the speaker is from England and most of them use the British accent. By doing that, the student can enhance their knowledge and also improve their skills.

The reason this research was conducted was that even in this modern era, many schools still use the old method to teach students. Unfortunately, the old method of teaching is not so relevant to this era and can make students not interested in learning the English language and find it boring and difficult.
